In September 2017, we became the first and only cable manufacturer globally to achieve Living Product Challenge certification on our CAT 6+ Low Smoke Halogen Free (LSHF) product. Our CAT 6+ LSHF product was just one of nine products at the time to achieve this rigorous certification from the International Living Future Institute.

In March 2018, we became the first and only cable manufacturer globally to obtain Declare labels on our CAT 6 with FEP Jacket and CAT 6A STP with FEP Jacket products.

Today, we are pleased to announce we believe the following Superior Essex products to be "Red List Free" to 100 ppm level and in compliance with the Living Building Challenge Red List 3.1 requirements:

- PowerWise 1G 4PPoE Low Smoke Halogen Free (LSHF) (Living Product Challenge Certification In Progress)
- 10 Gain XP Low Smoke Halogen Free (LSHF) (Living Product Challenge certification In Progress)

In combination with our Health Product Declarations for these products, we continue to lead the industry in transparency and reducing the hazardous chemistries within our products while also employing responsible sourcing practices. We will continue to monitor our supply chain and seek to obtain more transparent information in the future with goals to develop a Declare Label or achieve Living Product Challenge certification for these products in the near future.
